



The David White Woodlake Community Service Award

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

This award was created in 2015 to honor David White for his extraordinary service to the Woodlake Community. A resident of the Woodlake community since 1999, David has been serving as a volunteer in many capacities. He has directed the Building and Grounds committee as chair since 2006, joining the committee in 2000. As On-Site Coordinator, he is the liaison with the landscaping contractor, but continues doing much of the work himself. He joined the Board of Directors in 2001 and served as President from 2007-2015. David worked with the Durham Police Department to help establish a working and effective Neighborhood Watch Program and currently serves as co-chair. Perhaps his most challenging contribution was working with the City Public Works Department and the petition process to turn all private roads into public roads, a three-year task completed in 2009.

This award recognizes a member of the Woodlake Community for his or her exceptional service to the Woodlake community.

ELIGIBILITY:

Any current resident of the Woodlake Community who is not a current member of the WHOA Board of Directors.

NOMINATIONS:

Nominations may be made by any Woodlake homeowner, including from current members of the WHOA Board of Directors.

SELECTION OF CANDIDATE:

The WHOA Board of Directors will evaluate the nominees and select a recipient.

BASIC CRITERIA:

1. The nominee shall have been or is currently involved in volunteer service to the Woodlake Community.
2. The nominee may have previously served as a member of the WHOA Board of Directors, but not be currently serving.
3. The nominee may be a member of a sub-committee of the WHOA such as Architectural Review Committee, Building and Grounds or Recreational Committee, but not limited to committee service.
4. The nominee shall have been or is currently volunteering in a manner above and beyond normal service.
5. The nominee shall not have received remuneration for his or her services.

PROCEDURE:

A homeowner may complete the nomination form for any Woodlake resident.

Submissions must be made on the official nomination form available at woodlakecommunity.com.

Nominations are to be submitted to the WHOA Board of Directors (board@woodlakecommunity.com) by October 31.

AWARD PRESENTATION:

The award will be presented at the annual Volunteer Appreciation Evening in December and will be announced at the following annual meeting.

A plaque with the Recipient name and year of selection will be placed in the clubhouse.
